PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

DO NOT IGNORE THE **DETOUR SIGNS!**

As the guys are repairing our roads this summer, it is LAW that you follow the detour signs. If you choose to drive past them, into or through a work zone, you will be prosecuted and the fines are substantial.

> Please respect our workers' safety and drive intelligently!

IIJFFDS!

Be considerate of your neighbors and keep your weeds down. Dried weeds are a FIRE HAZARD. Walk your property and fence lines so that you can see where your weeds might be causing a problem for you and for your neighbor(s).

Rockvale municipal code regarding weeds can be found on the town website. So, let's all remove the weeds BEFORE they become a problem!

As you're probably aware, 2024 is an election year which includes some of our local Rockvale positions.

3 positions in Rockvale (Mayor, Trustee B. Mehring and Trustee J. Hart) will be up for a vote because those 3 seats were appointed.

There is currently one board vacancy and should it be filled by appointment before the election, it would require a vote as well.

All candidates running for office require a public announcement that they are running, a notarized Candidate Affidavit and a notarized Nomination Petition. Currently, no public announcements have been made, and no Candidate Affidavits have been received. Candidate Affidavit forms can be picked up at Town Hall

during business hours. Nomination Petitions will be made available per state deadlines and we'll keep you updated as we receive that

information. Make sure you're registered to vote!

WAYS TO PAY YOUR WATER BILL:

- Pay online at www.ub-pay.com Use Municipality Code: RockvaleCO244
- Pay with credit card by calling 719-784-4125
- Drop your check with the return stub into the water box slot on the front door of Town Hall
- Bring cash, check or credit card to Town Hall during business hours
- Set up monthly auto payment with your bank
