SCHOOL BUSES ARE ON THE ROAD

Please pay attention to the crosswalks

Colorado School Bus Law: You must stop your vehicle at least 20 feet before reaching a school bus that is stopped with its red lights flashing whether it is on your side of the road, the opposite side of the road, or at an intersection you are approaching. You must remain stopped until the flashing red lights are no longer operating.

- Pay with credit card by calling 719-784-4125
- Drop your check with the return stub into the water box slot on the front door of Town Hall
- Bring cash, check or credit card to Town Hall during business hours
- Set up monthly auto payment with your bank

OHVs/ATVs in Rockvale

In accordance with Ordinance 3, Series 2020, the town of Rockvale has specific regulations regarding Off Highway Vehicles/All Terrain Vehicles



that are operated within the town. Annual OHV/ATV license applications should be acquired at Town Hall where you can also pick up a copy of Ordinance 3, Series 2020. The annual license costs \$30.00 and you are required to provide proof of ownership and proof of insurance. Other regulations are listed in the ordinance in regard to age, nuisance regulations, helmet usage, among others.
