# Water Project Grant

Rockvale has been in the process of utilizing an extensive water project grant for close to 4 years. There have been delays along the way due to changes in requirements. Currently, Rockvale has been told that we need to have a chlorination building placed on property that will allow the proper chlorination for the residences on Churchill. GMS Consulting Engineers have given us specifications stating that the building would require a 30gallon feed tank holding bleach (the same as householduse bleach), with a small feed pump. The feed tank would also be held within a containment vessel. When properly handled, bleach is considered safe. This bleach is <u>NOT</u> a gaseous form of chlorine.

The town of Rockvale would prefer to have the chlorination building placed on a property that would make the chlorination worthwhile for the greatest number of residents possible. **Property owner cooperation would be appreciated in having this process run smoothly.** Residents in the area may be contacted by the town for input. Please don't hesitate to call town hall or Carl if you have questions regarding this process. **Without taking the proper steps, this important grant may be lost.** 



# SCHOOL BUSES ARE ON THE ROAD

# Please pay attention to the crosswalks

**Colorado School Bus Law:** You must stop your vehicle at least 20 feet before reaching a school bus that is stopped with its red lights flashing whether it is on your side of the road, the opposite side of the road, or at an intersection you are approaching. You must remain stopped until the flashing red lights are no longer operating.
